Brief PCRAFI Project background



Brief Introduction

- Disaster risk management associated with increasing climatic stressors are often a central and streamlined area for policies and programs in Pacific Island Countries (PICs). Estimates of average annual direct loss caused by natural disasters have reached US\$1.07 billion across all Pacific Small Island Developing States (UNESCAP, 2020). Across PICs, there is a high level of exposure to both seismic and climate-related hazards.
- This study documents the results from field data collected from over 10,000 assets across Tonga, Vanuatu, Solomon Islands and
 possibly Samoa.
- Pacific Catastrophe Risk & Financing Initiative (PCRAFI) was launched in launched in 2006. Phase I started in 2007 & Phase II in 2016
 - a. Pillar I: the PCRAFI Facility PacRIS, Data Collection, Data sharing
 - b. Pillar II: the PCRAFI Technical Assistance Program. The Capacity Building and Update of the Hazard and Exposure Database Project, which the Pacific Community (SPC) is implementing
- Develop disaster risk assessments tools and practical technical and financial applications to reduce and mitigate the impacts of natural hazards in 14 Pacific Island Countries

Brief Introduction continued...

- Pacific Risk Information System (PacRIS), in which risk profiles were developed, and the largest collection of georeferenced data organized for the region.
- Project to be implemented in 14 countries/Island states
- The Project aims to improve and update PacRIS and contribute towards strengthening the disaster risk finance and insurance capacity of PICs to provide coverage against the potential impacts of natural hazards, through the PCRAFI Program.

- GIS/Geonode Training




















Preliminary results of survey data collected - Kingdom of Tonga




Preliminary results of survey data collected - Republic of Vanuatu








Preliminary results of survey data collected - Samoa

- Co-operation between ministries/departments within countries, bridging the gap between silo's
- Step towards updating of risk profiles for countries
- Update towards national exposure database
- Open-sourced tools/software's sustainability
- Introducing sustainable, relevant, convenient workflows
- PacRIS centralized open-sourced data depository for countries (GeoNode)





















Looking Forward



- Through future discussions, would be of great benefit to have access to data collection templates that were being used within ministry/department or the actual data itself in order to accurately determine the gaps in data that can be targeted; also, to ensure there is no duplication of data. (pre-survey)
- There is a real need to guide conversations on an ongoing issue within countries of data accessibility, maintenance and utilization. Willingness of departments to share data, update data, plan and action long-term sustainability of not only the PacRIS platform but also their various ministry/department databases.
- Contextualizing of data collection templates and country training manuals to countries assets
- Opportunities to institutionalizing trainings conducted (Exposure Data Collection – KoBo Toolbox, Fundamentals of Exposure & Hazard Mapping Analysis on QGIS, etc)
